School Travel Plan – Claremont High School, Claremont Avenue

This consultation document outlines our proposals for a School Travel Plan scheme around Claremont High School in Claremont Avenue. Please read through the information in this document and then complete and return the enclosed questionnaire - **postage is free**. The closing date for the return of the questionnaires is: **16th December 2009**.



The School Travel Plan engineering measures were identified following submission of a School Travel Plan by the Claremont High School in Claremont Avenue, Kenton. The scheme proposals aim to improve road safety and sustainable travel options such as walking and cycling for children, parents and the road users in roads around the school.

Please see the drawing overleaf for full details of the scheme. The key points are outlined below.

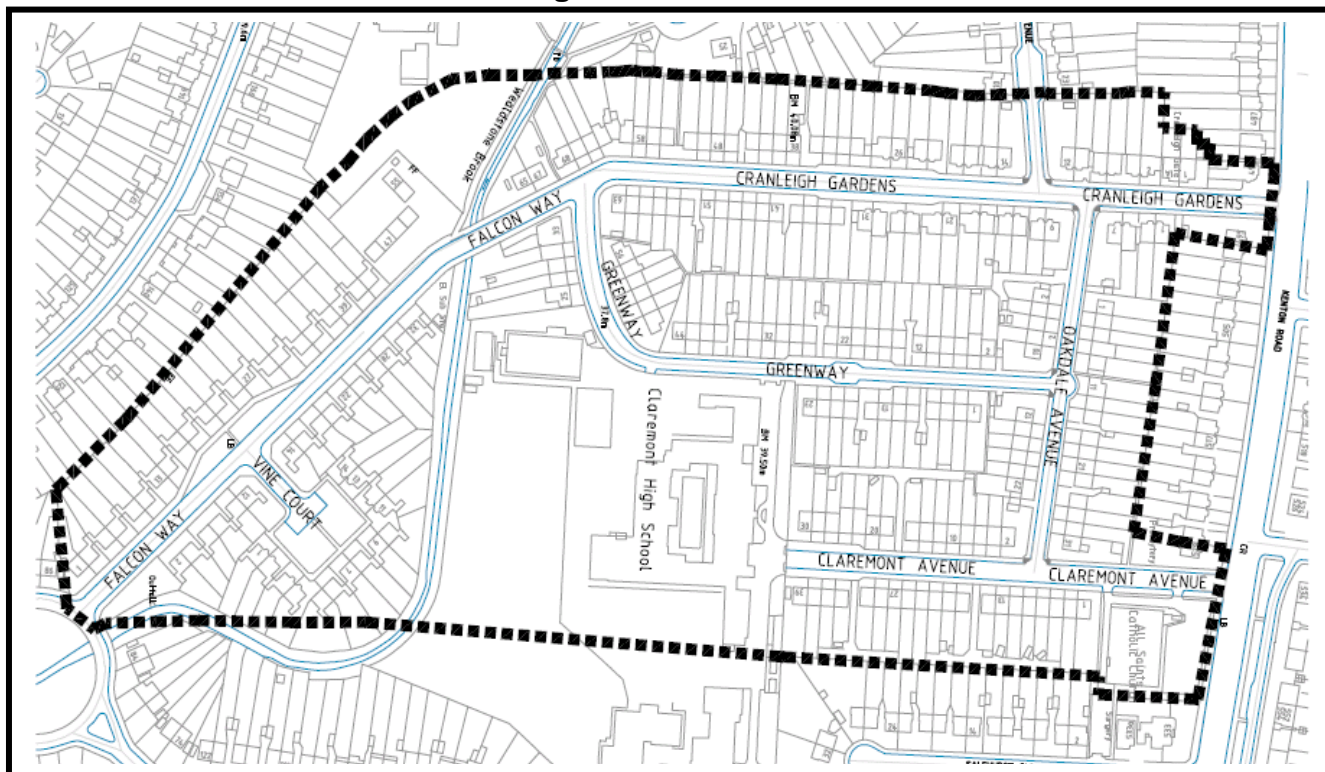
The proposed improvements include:

- Installation of a 20mph Zone in the area bounded by Kenton Road, Claremont Avenue, Cranleigh Gardens and Falcon Way. All 20mph zones have to be self enforcing. Traffic calming measures as shown on the enclosed plan are proposed. Reducing vehicle speeds would help to provide a safer environment and would help to encourage sustainable transport such as walking and cycling.
- Making Claremont Avenue one-way between Kenton Road and Oakdale Avenue to ease the congestion outside the school
- “At Any Time” waiting restrictions outside the school access gate, in Claremont Avenue and at junctions to remove the obstructive parking and improve visibility.
